In 1961 together they purchased the 40 acre farm located on the Stamp River where they raised their family and grew various field crops and root vegetables. In 2006 Rage's joined the growers of Vancouver Island Farm Products Inc. and currently has a total of 6 acres dedicated to the cucumber production. We are all familiar with the delicious cucumbers. Rages Farm typically employs approximately 40 people every season under the direction of General Manager Derek Bosma. 20,000 seedlings are planted in February and first harvest begins in late April. The cucumbers are shipped all over Vancouver Island. Sheldon is very proud to be a part of this incredible team.
